What is Dual Language Immersion?

Beginning in 5 year-old kindergarten, students receive language and literacy, science and mathematics instruction in a world language. They receive instruction in all other subject areas in English.

When is registration?

- **Online registration begins on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at 4:00 P.M.**
- Parents will access the online registration link by clicking on "World Languages" under the "Academics" header on the district's website (www.lexington1.net) or by visiting the World Language Micro-site at www.lexoneworldlanguages.weebly.com.
- At each dual language immersion school site, priority is given to students who are zoned for these schools.
- We reserve 10 spaces at each site for students who reside outside of that school's attendance zone.
- All dual language immersion students must reside in Lexington One and provide proof of residency upon enrolling for 5K kindergarten.
- Dual language immersion registration is held one week after 5K kindergarten enrollment closes.
- ***Please be sure to enroll your child at the school s/he is zoned for prior to registering for dual language immersion.***
